You should have received your giving receipts to enable you to claim your tax rebates. If worshippers at HPCC gave one third of their rebate to Youth South West Christchurch, that would more than cover the projected deficit and enable the Youth Workers to continue their ministry for another year – that's all it takes. It really costs us nothing because we would give to God's Kingdom whether we received the rebate or not. To receive one third back, and then give one third of what we receive back to YSWC would bring immense relief. **Can I ask you to prayerfully consider doing that?** We don't often talk about money but direct our requests to the Lord. But we thought if "we asked, we might receive" – someone said that once.

At the **AGM** we were reminded of **God's provision** once again for the mission of HPCC. Steve said sometimes it seems the math doesn't add up – but it seems to come from somewhere. *Thank you for your faithful and generous giving.* I trust you are learning the glorious and wonderful truth that "**God is no man's debtor**". I guarantee you never be worse off for having given to His Kingdom. I was speaking to some of our Youth Staff about giving last week and reminded them that if God doesn't get the first 10%, the enemy does. In **Malachi 3** God promises to keep the devourer away from them when they bring their tithes into the storehouse. My experience is consistent with that. When I have neglected to tithe, I never seem to have enough – the appliances break down, the cars need work done, something breaks or crashes – the devourer gets it plus more. But when I put God first, He returns it with blessing "*pressed down running over, in full measure*" Luke 6:38. **We don't make tithing a law or a requirement at HPCC.** Rather, it is a part of being a **disciple**. Nor do we limit it to 10%. The Lord says if we "**sow bountifully we will reap bountifully**" (2 Cor 8 & 9). We believe that how you use your money is a matter of discipleship – God is to be Lord of all – He wants to put money in and can take it out as He pleases.....thus it is a relationship issue, not a law to be followed. The only law involved is that of sowing and reaping, cause and effect.

Today is Mother's day – I was thinking of all that my Mum has contributed to my life. How do you put that into words without it seeming wordy, shallow and cliché. When I think of my Mum I think of her big heart – she would never see someone stuck. At one stage in our home in Dunedin we had two of my sisters friends, two cousins, and my grandmother all living with Mum, Dad and my 4 sisters – my youngest sister was 3 months old at the time, and Mum was 49. It never seemed to phase her – although she did often slip away to bed early for some reason, and not join in the card games!!! What was wrong with her???

To all Mum's have a blessed day – we salute you.

West Melton.

You might have noticed a new word flying around the newsletter and power point notices lately - MOPS. Not something to clean the floor with but a new ministry opportunity that has come our way called Mothers of Preschoolers. This was previously run by the Rolleston Community Church. They have passed it over to us and Catherine, in her role as community children's worker for extension congregations. She has taken a leading role in developing this further. Around 20 mums meet fortnightly for encouragement, discussion, craft activities and morning tea.

This week Catherine gave a talk on the importance of motherhood which is worth airing in this column.

"I've been reading a book lately called *The Mom Factor*. It talks about the influence mothers have on their children. The way we are parented and have our needs met as a child, influences our worldview, our relationships, our marriage, our career, our self image, our life, and how we parent. Good mums get good mothering – we can't give what we haven't received. We need to work on our own character issues. God who created and loves each and every one of us will place people in our lives who will help develop the areas of our personality and character that need developing, the bits that may have got missed as we grew up. Other people can 'mother' us (i.e. be the person who challenges us when it's needed, cares about us as a whole and complete, mature person).

Good enough vs perfect – give up the super mum model of motherhood. I was reading in a January issue of the Woman's Weekly an article about Judy Bailey and the Brainwave Trust. She talked about the juggle of career and parenthood saying something like we have been sold a lie that women can do anything and have it all at the same time. There is a cost to this way of life, and it is often seen reflected in the lives of our children. Not to say we *can't* do everything, just that *there are seasons*. Research has shown that *those first 3 years of your child's life and you being there for them is more beneficial than was ever realized.*"
