## Mission Leadership Team

You may recall our **Strategic Vision document**, where our goal was to double in size over 5-7 years, with 80% of that growth coming from people who do not know the Lord. It initially seems like a pipe-dream. But when you seriously think about each of us winning one person for Christ over a 5-7 year period – seen in these terms it no longer seems a pipe-dream but rather “surely that is achievable”. Each of us bringing one person to Christ in 5-7 years – is that too much to expect?

**Where do we start?** The place to begin is to ask: “Lord, lay upon my heart the people or a person you want me to pray for. Show me that person”. I believe that the Lord will have people in the ‘circle of contacts’ of all of us who He is preparing. In **Acts 1:8** Jesus said their witness was to begin in “Jerusalem, Judea, Samaria and to the ends of the earth.” In other words it was to begin with **where they already were**. The Lord has placed us alongside of people in our workplace, neighbourhoods, leisure activities, to whom we are to be His witness – both by our lives, and by our words when the time is appropriate.

Once we know **who**, then what?

**2 Cor 4:4** states that *“the god of this world has blinded the mind of unbelievers, so that they cannot see the light of the gospel of the glory of Christ...”* So the place to begin is to pray earnestly that God will open the eyes of the people he lays upon our hearts. This is a spiritual work and a spiritual battle and it therefore requires spiritual weapons. Pray that the veil be removed and that a hunger arises in their hearts. Pray regularly for them and trust the Lord to open up ways of interaction and relationship opportunities. Another useful strategy is to remember the **power of group prayer**. The scripture says: *“When one prays one thousand flees; when two prays ten thousand flees”*. If you can pray with another person then you multiply the prayer power – what a great opportunity for husbands and wives, and families.

*I was encouraged recently when reading of the **birth of the Presbyterian Church in Scotland**. It was birthed in a time of spiritual revival. John Knox’s son in law was **John Welch**, who was widely known for his commitment to regular prayer and fasting. It was so much so that the flesh on his knees became like the “horn of a cow”, so hard and calloused. He had such a burden for His nation – and followed the call of God to take the gospel to some of the most dangerous and darkest corners of Scotland. The men he mentored were key players in the later movements of revival; and his prayers and labours brought much fruit to areas considered impenetrable by many. **It makes great reading and causes a yearning in my heart for such a move of God’s Spirit. I cannot see any other way for our nation to emerge from its current downhill slide and prayer remains a key to that.***

## West Melton.

One of the metaphors God has given me for West Melton's ministry has been that of the watering hole. In the dry season in Africa animals will trek for weeks in search of watering holes. They are driven by their great thirst and need of water. I see West Melton as a spiritual watering hole where people can quench their thirst for God among a community of people who love God and each other.

I've been reminded this week of this picture because of all the rain we've received. This rain is very welcome in this naturally dry area. The watering hole picture has even become literal this week as the car park has turned into a lake forcing me to be creative about where I park so that I can get into my office with dry feet!

Last Sunday we entered a new season in the church's calendar - Pentecost. It was a real thrill to pray for those who wanted to receive the Holy Spirit into their lives. This is the gift Jesus promised his followers so that they would be empowered to follow him and be his witnesses. In fact the Spirit is likened to thirst quenching water; "Let anyone who is thirsty come to me, and let the one who believes in me drink". As the scripture has said, 'Out of the believer's heart shall flow rivers of living water'. (John 7:37b-38).

By filling us with his Spirit we have something to offer those around us who are thirsty. Here are some things people are thirsty for:

- Acceptance and belonging - many of our communities are fractured. The church offers a place where people understand the value of community and seek to practice this.
- Purpose and meaning to life - many people wonder if this world is heading anywhere other than down the 'gurgler'. We know it is heading towards God's ultimate plan of redemption and he is in control.
- Moral guidance - many people are concerned about the modern 'anything goes' morality and the impact this is having on society. The Christian community offers an unchanging moral compass and a degree of certainty around ethics not found in the world.

Let us continue to do our part as we welcome new comers to the watering hole, offering them friendship and warm fellowship. And may we be empowered by the Holy Spirit to spread the good news of Jesus to all we encounter.

### Life Conference 2010

Last week a team of 13 went to Auckland to attend the annual Life conference. Its focus is to equip leaders, and as always God moved and challenged us all in our relationship with Him, and our calling in serving as part of His Mission. The speakers are world class with the likes of Brian Houston (Sydney), Paul Scanlon (UK) and Robert Morris (USA) all bringing fantastic messages. Paul de Jong from Auckland always brings a consistent, inspiring message of God's Kingdom moving in our nation. Some of the thoughts from the team include:

- "It was an awesome few days. I felt really challenged to put God's kingdom first and really make it a priority in my life" – Abi .
- "From anticipation to brief initial skepticism giving way to a week of life changing teaching. God challenged me at Life to put more emphasis on relationship with others and stepping out in faith, to take risks" – Isaac.
- "I had a fresh revelation that this life isn't about me but what I could do for his Kingdom, hoping to reflect his glory and love" - Kim.
- "Felt challenged about certain areas of my life – re: tithing, prayer time and having a (true) sabbath. Also some of what I learnt, I feel that I can apply to my leadership role within Warehouse Stationery as well as at church" - Byron.
- "A really good time away with members of the team; I felt we reached a new level of relationship with one another and in amongst it all shared a great many laughs. I've been challenged to work further on breaking down the unconscious boundaries I place God within at times. Confining him to what I can understand and 'work with', yet still expecting Him to respond from His supernatural attributes" – Olivia.
- "Having the ability to spend time with others, learning more about the Lord, his place in my life, and how I can effectively live for him was great" – Steve.
- "It was awesome to be at Life for a second time. We feel so re-filled, re-energised, passionate and ready to step into what God is calling us to in our life together." – Dan & Sharon

As you can see, it's not about church leadership – it's about life in general and living our lives for Him and His Kingdom. Next year they are expanding the conference to include all areas of church life, as well as professional and business teaching looking at how you can live your life for Him in your context.
