Mission Leadership Team

A big thank you to you all for your prayers and messages of comfort to us all and particularly to Janice on the death of her Mum. We really appreciate it. Thank you also to those who attended the funeral and to the **staff team** who stepped in for the week and encouraged Janice and I to take a weekend out. This was invaluable in giving Janice the chance to debrief and talk of the last week she spent beside her Mum's hospital bed. It certainly helps in processing and expression of emotions. Thank you so much for the space to do that.

There was a good lesson for us to learn from Mavis's death – **the importance of finishing well**. Mavis had always shown some inclination towards the Lord, but in the last 5 years this became more overt and obvious, and during the last couple of years Janice had some significant conversation and prayer with her. The last week was especially precious as they shared their hope for the future. Some, when they face trials and hardship, harden their hearts towards God – Mavis was drawn closer and closer to him - and so were the whole family. We had some great conversations with members of the extended family. Let me also acknowledge the significant impact **Gilbert** made in Mavis' life. It began with a word of encouragement at one of our kids weddings; this was followed by phone calls and cards. Amongst Mavis's box of treasures were two cards which she often read from Gilbert. She was really moved by his loving concern and expressions of compassion and this helped warm her heart towards God. In the end, Mavis was pleading to die and be released into the arms of the Lord. I trust I finish as well as she did.

Another example of the "body at work" came as a result of a visit I made on Wednesday night. This family has been significantly impacted – their marriage has improved, the whole family has come into a new faith in the Lord, and when I enquired of their faith journey, the links were interesting:

ICONZ for boys had made a significant impact on their son – he kept requesting Mum to read Bible stories to him; Mum came in contact with **Linda** through home schooling and eventually was invited to Church. She enjoyed the **services** and found the teaching something she could apply to her life – the kids loved **Rock of Life**; Dad enjoys **ICONZ** and the relationships with the leaders and worships at his Catholic Church. They decided to support the **Rolleston Outreach** and become part of that team – they enjoy the small groups meetings and prayer on Fridays with **Brent and Heather**; and Mum comes into **Woman 2 Woman** for additional teaching. They are now enquiring about Alpha, Marriage Courses and Baptism.

I left thinking to myself – it is working. Often we don't hear of the impact – but all of these links have been crucial in this family coming to faith. Yeah Lord.

We welcome Hamish and Anne to our services today and pray for the Lord's blessing and encouragement for them as they minister amongst us.

Growth Groups

I once read a quote that impressed me; "look around and see where God is at work then ask Him if you can join in"

When I see 450 people attending Small groups and over 70 are so keen they attend more than one group, some even attend up to five separate groups! There must be something happening!

With 34 Growth Groups to chose from, all caring for each other and helping each other grow, it's got to be good for you!

The group I belong to has spent four meetings looking at the Lords prayer and have now started to look at Jesus' prayer in John 17. I'm so impressed at how much Jesus cared for the group he spent approximately three years with. Not only that, he also prayed for all those "who will believe in me through their message". That's you and me! His group is still having an impact today. What is the impact of our groups on those around us and the future?

I'm reading a booklet called "The Door of Hope" by Lisa. It tells the true story of five busy missionary ladies in China who came together from different missions to pray for and put into action something for "the fallen women in China", (women sold into prostitution). A large percentage were girls sold by their parents. From a little group meeting regularly to pray in 1899, these ladies kept on meeting and encouraging each other and interceding for a work that they were not directly involved in. They wrote a leaflet and sent it to missionaries all over China, exposing the situation. From the response a rescue mission was born and it grew to become huge over the next 50 plus years. This mission saw law changes and the government asking for help with all these young girls.

If you are not in a group I would like to encourage you to get involved in what God is doing amongst us and beyond!
