## Mission Leadership Team

**New Life:** When was the last time a Presbyterian Church was involved in a new congregation being established (other than onsite)?

Those with long memories will have examples, many in the 50-60s (and perhaps 70s), as new suburbs were opening up and there were a proliferation of new congregations established. There was a confidence that every community needed a strong church, and an understanding that "this is part of what we should be about" in the longer established congregations.

Next year, Hornby will be involved in developing a new congregation in Rolleston. It is a deliberate, intentional church plant into a community that is growing strongly (projections are to 14,000 within 10 years). The Presbytery has approved our application (from Press Go – a new initiative fund) granted to us. These steps are great and encouraging – but not why we're doing it.

During the strategic plan process there was a sense of call to the "South West" of Christchurch – the link with West Melton/Halkett was a response to this, as is Youth South West Christchurch. We felt God was calling us to widen our vision and grow our heart for communities outside of Hornby-Hei Hei. Then there was a gentle unfolding of possibilities: the council seeking to partner a church group to establish youth work in Rolleston - which led to Lani and Jono starting work in Rolleston and the development of a relationship with the local school, the fantastic work of the team with children and their question to me regularly: Where can we link these kids into? A good number of Hornby families living in Rolleston and praying for their community, some of whom would love to worship and minister there as well. More recently, we were asked to take over a "MOPs" ministry in the area, a new children's church starting on Sunday mornings with families from Hornby taking the lead ... all the way through it just seems like the Lord has been in it as our Elders, Intercessors and prayer meetings have sought him and covered the journey. The next step is a worshipping community – one with the values, life and ethos the Lord has led us to at HPCC, but that expresses those things in the unique way that is best suited for Rolleston.

Planting a new church isn't something that happens "out there" it will be a significant part of our life together at Hornby too – as nature shows us in the arrival of a child nothing new is born without sacrifice and enormous effort, and the original "home" is never the same! Of the new addition we'd also say afterwards – we'd never want it any other way.

So please prayerfully prepare for a new, substantial addition to our church household – a Rolleston congregation – if you'd like to know more feel free to talk to me, or if possible come along to the evening on the 21<sup>st</sup> of July – this is for anyone interested. Can I also mention that you don't need to live in Rolleston to be part of establishing the congregation – if God's calling you to help with that I'd love to talk with you some more.

## West Melton

This week we have had the pleasure of running a school holiday programme, "West Melton Super Kids" was based on a super hero theme. We have averaged 23 five to nine year olds over the three days and the children have been learning about how Jesus is a true super hero.

Day one focused on him raising Jairus' daughter from the dead showing he has power even over death. They also learned that Jairus was a hero because he continued to believe in Jesus even after he was told his little girl had died.

On day 2 we focused on the feeding of the 5,000 and how those who believe in Jesus will never go hungry - he will satisfy our deepest longings. In this story is a very ordinary hero - the boy who gave up his lunch. This act of generosity enabled a spectacular miracle to happen.

On day 3 we learned that Jesus had power over nature, which he demonstrated by walking on the water. The ordinary hero in this story was Peter who acted in faith when Jesus invited him to walk on water. Heroes often need to have faith and courage, just like Peter did.

It has been wonderful to see the children fully engaged in the various activities on offer. The pictures show them making place mats and a game where contestants had to 'rescue the spider' from the bowl of jelly using just their mouths. What child wouldn't want to plant their face in jelly? Well done Anika who won this one!

Feedback from parents and kids was really encouraging as the previous links from Rugrats/Mainly Music and Julie's contacts through school (Bibles in Schools last year and as a teacher aide there) have built a large bank of trust. They are happy to send their children along having had a positive experience of our church people they have met.

A big pat on the back needs to go to Julie and Catherine for organizing such a wonderful event and all those who helped make it happen.
